## INSTRUCTIONS FOR SCHEDULING YOUR COLLECTIONS

Contact the appropriate Clinical Labs of Hawaii, LLP facility above and provide them with the following information:

- Please provide:
1. Client number, Name of Employer
  2. Name & Phone No. of Employer Representative
  3. Name & Identification number of donor, Expected time of arrival
  4. Indicate Urine Drug Screen, Breath Alcohol or Both, DOT or Non-DOT
  5. Indicate reason for test: Post Accident or Reasonable Suspicion

- Supervisor/Designated Employer Representative escort required for Reasonable Suspicion collections and recommended for Post Accident collections.
- Donor is to bring in proper identification (State Driver's License is preferred). Supervisor identification is acceptable.
- If applicable, donor is to bring in Chain of Custody forms and/or collection kits.

According to Department of Transportation (DOT) 49 CFR Part 382.303 a post-accident breath alcohol test (BAT) should be conducted within 2 hours of the accident. If a BAT test is not conducted within 8 hours after the accident, no test should be conducted. Post-accident urine drug screen should be collected within 32 hours after the accident, otherwise no urine drug test shall be administered. According to 49 CFR Part 40.61 (b) (2) If an employee needs medical attention, do not delay this treatment to collect a specimen. For this reason CLH will not perform any collection in an Emergency Room. All collections will be performed only after the donor has been discharged from medical care.

**After Hours** is defined as any period outside the lab’s normal business hours or observed holidays and is subject to all after hour fees.
